'The Clyde' shopping centre in Glasgow underwent major refurbishment and extension works to provide an attractive, safe and secure environment. The shopping Centre was nominated for The British Council of Shopping Centres "Refurbishment and Extension Award".

The works included the installation of a glazed roof above the existing open mall, together with new entrances, emergency exits, toilet facilities, lift and escalators. The refurbishment will provide an additional 50,000 ft² to the retail space and 400 car-parking spaces to the 2000 already in existence.
